SUMMARY:

This position supports the mission of Sunrise Ranch by troubleshooting and repairing IT system infrastructure, hardware, phones and television systems.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Manages Care Desk trouble-ticket reporting system by distributing and reassigning tasks related to hardware and software issues
- Performs system hardware setup and configuration and manages standard maintenance procedures
- Troubleshoots, maintains, repairs and manages operating system software on all devices—Windows OS, Apple OS, Android, and iOS
- Troubleshoots, maintains, repairs and manages network system, including routers, switches, hubs, firewalls, VOIP switches, VDSL switches, CAT5 and fiber cables
- Troubleshoots, maintains and repairs phone and telecom systems, including PBX and VDSL modems
- Troubleshoots, maintains, upgrades and/or repairs workstations, printers, scanners, monitors and television drops, etc.
- Diagnoses and resolves computer virus-related issues
- Trains end users in standard operation of hardware and software when necessary
- Performs software and hardware inventory procedures
- Communicates with other team members, other departments, consultants, support staff and vendors for resolution of issues
- Purchases system and computer hardware and software as approved by manager
