Keahi focused the power of prayer from around the world through a chant born out of her Hawaiian heritage. The wind turned, blowing back on the fire, keeping Sunrise Ranch safe.

Thank you, Keahi. Thank you, Chase.

This experience highlights how the power of Holy Spirit is working in the world today. In the thick of all that is transpiring in human culture, there are people who are spiritually in place. Their hearts and minds are open. The Highest Love is reverberating through them. The Light of Truth is shining through their presence. They are the comforter for the world.

These are Emissaries of Divine Light, many known to us, and many more we have never met and probably never will. With all that I am, I am saying, *Thank you for being one of us. Thank you for shining the light that you are in the world.*

The Gate House team can be proud of how we have stewarded the Centre and our community safely through the turbulent pandemic waters of 2020—and the journey continues!

The Centre certainly took a financial knock when we had to close down the Conferencing and Wellness Centre for seven months. At the same time, we chose to extend financial support to our Wellness practitioners, who otherwise would have had to close shop entirely. With no staff able to travel to work, It was now up to Gate House residents to take over care of the garden and keeping the centre clean. Since we were all having to stay home anyway, rallying together as a family was truly heartwarming and allowed us to support our decision to provide our loyal staff members full pay over the lockdown period. This was the least we could do! Many people in South Africa lost their jobs during the months of lockdown.

After seven long months, we were able to reopen the Gate House Conference and Wellness Centre and invite our Centre staff back to work! This was done with great care. Health checks, hygiene and sanitation protocols were put in place that met international safety standards.

The Centre's garden is blooming gorgeous! (See pictures on right.)

Right now it looks like the Wellness Centre will be fully booked for the year ahead! The Mankind Project I-Groups have started up again and will be back with us in 2021. We have just hosted a young girls group, "Kids Who Can," a rite of passage workshop for young girls. After our final public event for 2020 (an intimate wedding ceremony), the Gate House Operations team will meet to celebrate this year and vision and plan for 2021. ~ Ellinor B. Shepherd

In November the Cape Town Centre hosted Evolutionary Dialogues with the theme "Unity in Diversity." Nic and Ann Paton (pictured above) led the discussion. The motto of the coat of arms of South Africa means "people who are different come together." As we move beyond modernity into uncharted territory, a full appreciation of diversity, with its challenges and blessings, is starting to come into view and was a focus of the dialogue in this meeting.

Over 50 attended this year's Servers Council held October 1-4, with David Karchere (Director of Emissaries of Divine Light), the International Emissary Trustees, and others. It all occurred over Zoom, with the COVID-19 restrictions. The Council included the formation of Servers 2021 as a collective drum, bringing the pulse of Spirit into the world as well as a heightened awareness of the principles of our service.

There were online forums to facilitate an evolving dialogue; reports from several on unfolding creative opportunities; Attunement, including several who spoke about what is opening up in their awareness of Attunement; updates on the Creative Field program; online pairs and small groups; storytelling; a writing workshop with poetry and prose, portraying the divine poetry of our message; the arts and video; offline preparation work; journaling; and more. We even shared in online coffee breaks!

The annual Congress session was held on October 2, with representation from all the regions worldwide. During this time the Trustee election was held. There were three open seats this year. Marilyn Manderson (Kamloops, BC) and Keahi Ewa (Sunrise Ranch), who had been serving as Trustees, both re-nominated themselves for another two-year term; and Anne-Lise Bure (Cape Town, South Africa) self-nominated. As there were no other nominations, these three were unanimously acknowledged by the Congress as joining the remaining Trustees: David Karchere (Sunrise Ranch), Jane Anetrini (Loveland, CO), Hugh Duff (Edenvale, BC), and Howard Goodman (Cape Town, South Africa). It was announced that the Expanded Trustee Circle will also include Uma Faith (Sunrise Ranch), Oren Yakovee (Sunrise Ranch), and Sece Foster (Loveland, CO). Thankfulness was expressed for this new configuration of leadership.

Sunrise Ranch Community Evacuated Due to Fire Danger

The Cameron Peak Fire moved swiftly as a firebreathing dragon, with many weeks of red sun, red moon and dense smoke before moving within one mile of Sunrise Ranch.

October 16th the Sunrise Ranch community and surrounding area were mandated to evacuate. Our Sunrise Team had an evacuation plan in place, as well as a shelter plan for housing. Housing was graciously provided by friends, family and the American Red Cross.

Keahi Ewa, Chase Niedermeier, Nick Wamsley, Brian Mullen, and our friend and neighbor at Eden Valley Institute, Ignacio Perez, remained to care for Sunrise Ranch during power outages, water shutdowns and other emergencies, keeping the way clear for firefighters and heavy equipment. Many thanks to them.

The night of October 24th came the miraculous blessing of two days of snowfall, with high wind shifting back on itself, quelling a large portion of the fire. The afternoon of October 27th, after twelve days as evacuees, we were given safe passage to return home.

Prayers from so many around the world surrounded us and our precious Eden Valley in safekeeping. We are deeply grateful for everyone's outpouring of love and enfoldment. Thank you all! We also give thankfulness to all the firefighters for their diligence, integrity and steady commitment in protecting our land, homes, and all we hold dear.

Silence and pristine peace welcomed our return to Sunrise Ranch, along with hundreds of elk seeking refuge in the east pasture. We rejoiced in deep thankfulness to come home to a new cycle of being, tangible to touch, under the clear, blue Colorado sky of possibility.
